The Miracle League of Valdosta is a community-based sports program for children and adults with all types of mental and physical disabilities. The Miracle League of Valdosta would like to provide everyone of mental or physical handicap the opportunity to play baseball and other activities.

In partnership with the Valdosta
Lowndes Parks & Recreation, the
league is set to host it's second season
September 23rd, 2014 at Freedom
Park. Plans are currently underway for
the construction of a fully accessible
complex. The specialized field will
feature a cushioned, synthetic,
rubberized surface that will eliminate
any barriers to wheelchairs, walkers or
other mobility devices. The facility will
also include a handicap concession
stand, a pavilion and a barrier-free
playground that will be accessible to
children of all abilities.



Needs and Opportunities

According to the Georgia Disability Population Statistics, there are more than 1 million disabled people ages 5-64. Among this population of disabled people, an unmet need exists for recreational opportunities that help provide a well-rounded experience for the players and family. No other program like the Miracle League assures parents and family that all safety elements are in place to provide a safe, successful game experience for the players.

With the growing demand for the Miracle League program, there is an opportunity for us to expand in South Georgia. The Miracle League of Valdosta will develop a plan to manage our growth and impact, based on evidence of community need, community capacity to fund the program, community capacity to provide the volunteers needed to support the program, and community leadership committed to implementing the program.
