Eligibility: Women who are pregnant, not eligible for Medicaid, or uninsured or underinsured, and whose family income is at or below 250% of federal poverty level.

Perinatal Case Management (PCM) - Nurses and social workers provide pregnant women and their families with individual assessments and follow-up throughout their pregnancies linking them with prenatal care, Children 1st, and other medical and social services.

Eligibility: All Medicaid recipients who are pregnant.

Pregnancy Related Services (PRS) - A Medicaid program, focused on reducing infant illness and death rate and improving the quality of life for new mothers and their infants. Provides in home health assessments and teaching for women who have recently delivered a baby.

Resource Mothers - The resource mothers program connects experienced mother with pregnant and parenting teenagers who need guidance and support.

Eligibility: This program is designed for pregnant and parenting adolescents and young adults.

Right from the Start Medicaid (RSM) – The RSM program expands Medicaid coverage for pregnant women and children under the age of 19 with income levels at or above the federal poverty line. Eligibility is dependent on applicant, family size, family income, pregnancy status, and the federal poverty level.
